| Henry William Hunter | Royal Berkshire Regiment 2 nd Battalion | 17579 | Private | 21 st September 1916 | Killed in action | Vermelles British Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France | 28 | Little Coxwell | 25 th November 1887 |
| Frederick Nash | Royal Berkshire Regiment 2 nd /4 th Battalion | 203098 | Sergeant | 19 th May 1918 | Died of wounds | Aire Communal Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France | 31 | Tadley, Hampshire | 31 st August 1886 |
| John Henry Hanna | Gloucestershire Regiment 8 th Battalion | 23938 | Private | 20 th September 1917 | Wounded, killed in action | No known grave, commemorated at Tyne Cot Memorial, Zonnebeke, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium | 20 | Little Coxwell | 14 th August 1897 |
| Jesse Preston | Royal Berkshire Regiment 2 nd Battalion | 5731 | Private | 27 th May 1918 | Killed in action at the battle of the Aisne | Initially buried at Berry-au-Bac, subsequently moved to Jonchery-sur-Vesle British Cemetery, France | 36 | Little Coxwell | 13 th September 1881 |
| Albert Ernest King | Royal Berkshire Regiment 1 st /4 th Battalion Transport Section | 203187 | Private | 22 nd September 1918 | Died in London from wounds received in Italy | St. Mary's churchyard, Little Coxwell | 20 | Little Coxwell | 15 th November 1897 |
| Harry Kibble | Royal Field Artillery D Battery 112 th Brigade | L22958 | Bombardier | 8 th October 1918 | Killed in action | Bellicourt British Cemetery, Aisne, France | 20 | Buscot | 31 st March 1898 |
